

# Tuberculosis Requirement Guideline

*For internal and student use.*

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To attend any clinical course, each student must prove a tuberculosis (TB) status of “inactive”. *Anyone with an “active” TB status will not be allowed to attend clinical courses.*

- This requirement is a one-time requirement unless otherwise specified in your clinical onboarding process.
- Include all documentation related to testing, past infection, x-ray, and review of symptoms notes.

- *Upload your requirements documentation to ACEMAPP.*

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## To fulfill this requirement, you must:

1. Receive one *negative* blood test, either QuantiFERON-TB Gold (Q-gold) or T-Spot.  
OR
2. Receive a *negative* result on a two-step PPD skin test  
*\*\*the second PPD test must be administered between 7 and 21 days after the first to be considered compliant*  
AND
3. Complete the risk assessment questionnaire in ACEMAPP once  
AND
4. Complete the annual education module in ACEMAPP

If you receive a **positive TB** result now or at some time in the past, from a skin test or blood test, upload documentation showing:

- The positive test result.
- A negative chest x-ray, taken within the last **five years**.
- A Review of Symptoms Note from your provider indicating no active TB symptoms are present.
- Renew this requirement annually by submitting an updated Review of Symptoms Note from your provider.
