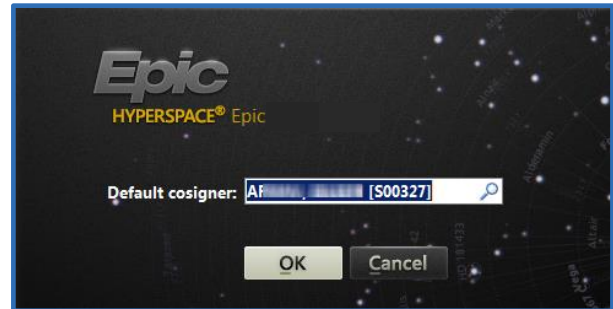


Co-signature for Nursing Students

During Log-In, nursing students are prompted to enter in the name of the co-signer.

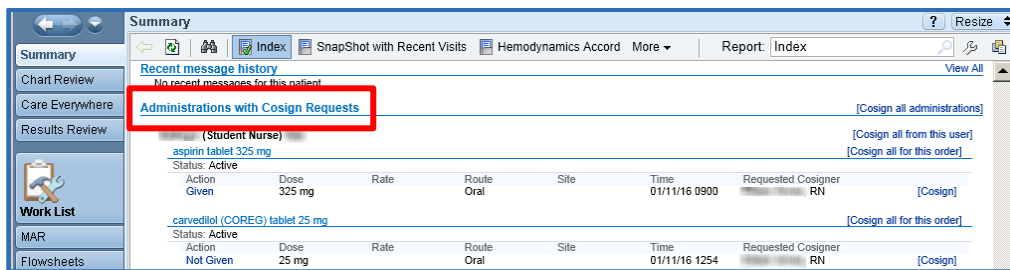
The student's documentation can be co-signed by this user.



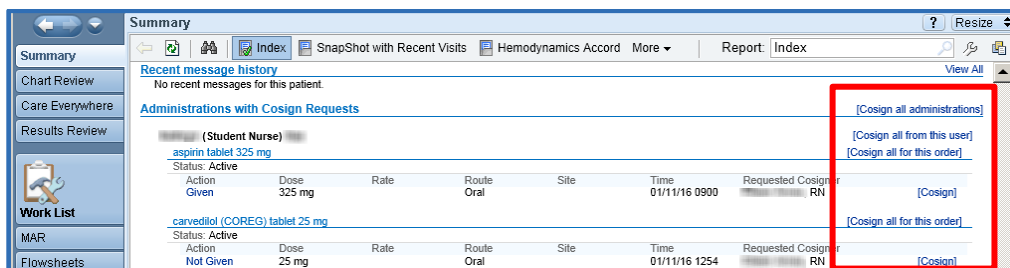
Try It Out

Cosign Medication Administrations

1. Open patient's chart.
2. From the **Summary** activity, scroll down to **Administrations with Cosign Requests**.



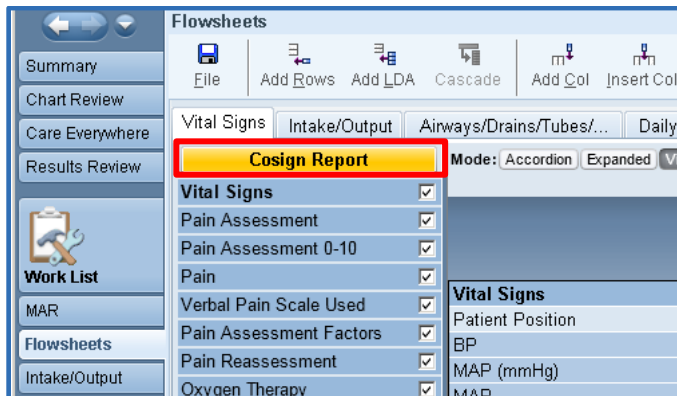
3. The nursing instructor may cosign the following ways by clicking on the corresponding blue hyperlink of that description:
 - a. Cosign all administrations
 - b. Cosign all from this user
 - c. Cosign all for the order
 - d. Cosign each administration separately



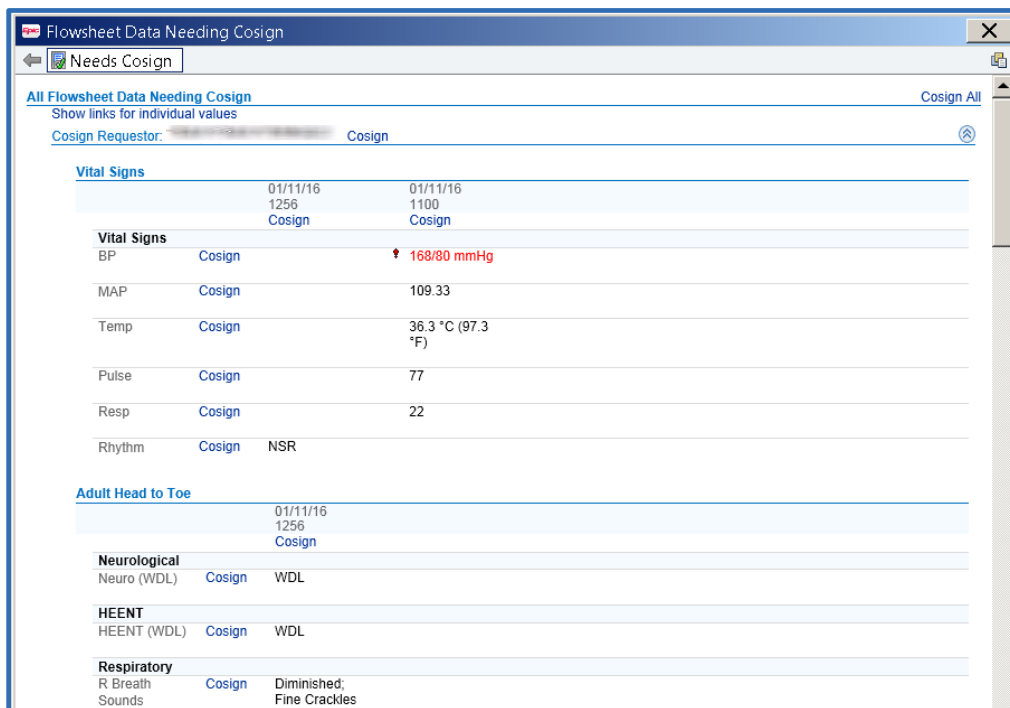
Note: After all the Medication Administrations have been cosigned, the *Administrations with Cosign Requests* section collapses and states *None*.

1. Open Flowsheets activity.
2. Click the yellow **Cosign Report** button.

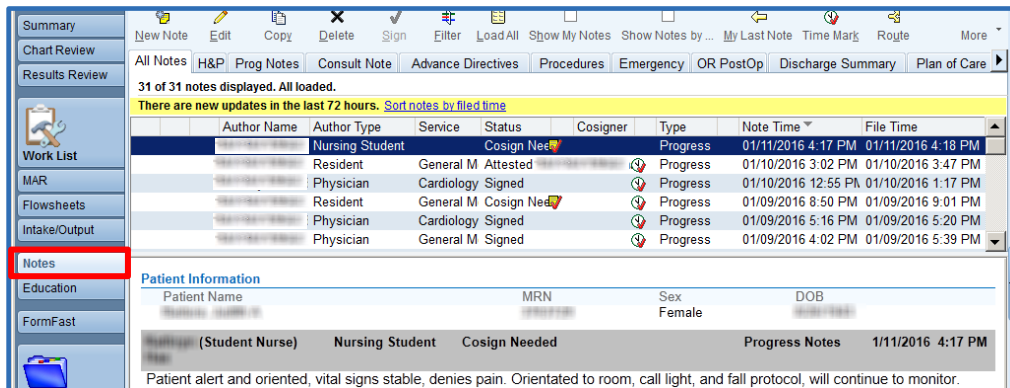


3. The *Flowsheet Data Needing Cosign* window opens. Click the blue Cosign hyperlink to cosign each assessment.

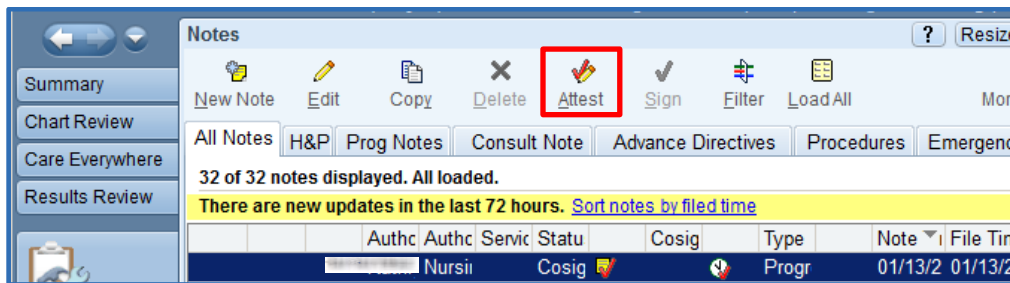


Cosign Notes

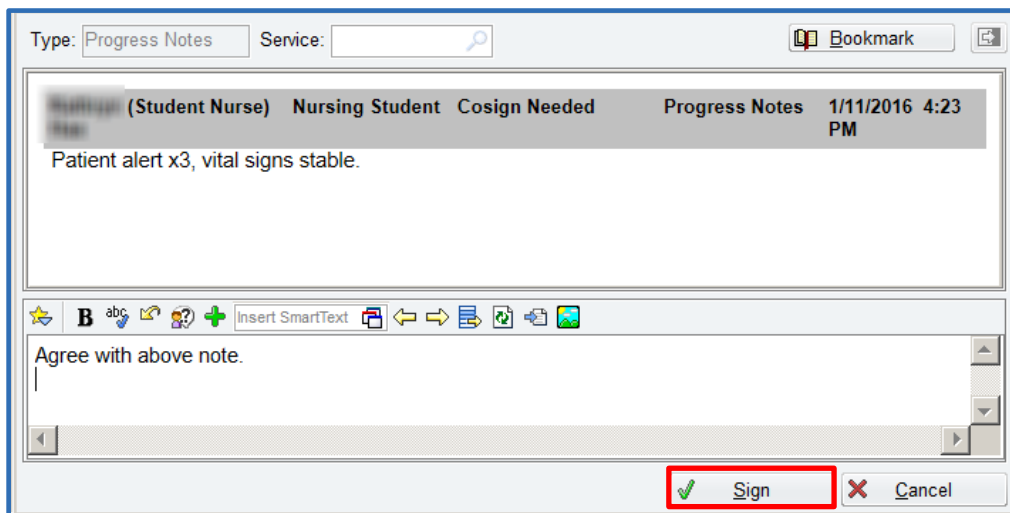
1. Open the **Notes** activity.



2. Click the note to be cosigned.
3. From the top tool bar, select **Attest**.



4. A window opens for the Instructor to make additional comments to be attached to the student's note.
5. **Sign** the note.



6. A cosigned note appears as illustrated below.
